

## Pupil premium funding 2018/19

The Secretary of State for Education lays down the following terms and conditions on which assistance is given in relation to the pupil premium grant (PPG) payable to schools and local authorities for the financial year beginning 1 April 2018. PPG provides funding for two policies:

- raising the attainment of disadvantaged pupils of all abilities to reach their potential
- supporting children and young people with parents in the regular armed forces

The grant may be spent in the following ways:

- for the purposes of the school, that is for the educational benefit of pupils registered at that school
- for the benefit of pupils registered at other maintained schools or academies
- on community facilities; for example, services whose provision furthers any charitable purpose for the benefit of pupils at the school or their families, or people who live or work in the locality in which the school is situated

The grant does not have to be completely spent by schools in the financial year beginning 1 April 2017, some or all of it may be carried forward to future financial years.

Pupil premium funding was introduced in 2011 to help schools to close the attainment gap between children from different socio-economic backgrounds.

## Pupils who qualify for pupil premium are:

- eligible for free school meals or have been eligible in the previous six years
- children who have been looked after, or are covered by a guardianship or residency order
- have been adopted from care
- have a parent serving in the armed forces
